

PAINTER

JOB SUMMARY Perform a variety of skilled work involving painting interiors and exteriors of new or existing buildings, furniture, and equipment. Perform general maintenance and repairs on equipment utilized in trade. Assist other personnel in performing general building maintenance duties as required.

TYPICAL DUTIES Prepare new and previously painted surfaces for painting, staining, varnishing, and finishing by water blasting, stripping, sanding, patching, puttying, priming and cleaning. Apply paint, stains, varnishes, lacquers or other protective and decorative coatings using brushes, rollers or spray equipment. Paint a variety of structures and equipment including exterior and interior building surfaces, floors, furniture, equipment and signs. Lay out and paint parking lots, basketball and volley ball courts, and other areas using striping machine. Make and post various signs as required. Repair and paint football scoreboards and goal posts. Remove graffiti using water or sandblaster and various chemicals. Operate compressors and other spray equipment. Erect scaffolding and rigging; spread drop cloths where necessary. Mix paint and match colors. Clean brushes and other tools and materials. Perform other duties related to this position.

JOB REQUIREMENTS Any combination of education, training, and/or experience which demonstrate ability to perform the required duties. A typical qualifying background would include graduation from high school or equivalent and demonstrated journey level painting experience which includes repairing interior and exterior surfaces such as plastering and drywall finishing.

Knowledge of: Methods, practices and procedures of the painting trade. Materials and equipment used to paint major projects. Safe and approved methods in the use and disposal of paints and chemicals contacted in the course of duty. Methods of preparing all types of surfaces for painting. Methods of applying all types of paints and other finishes. Proper methods used in cleaning and caring for brushes and other painting equipment. Safe work practices.

Ability to: Professionally paint a variety of surfaces and equipment. Rig and work from scaffolding. Work in confined spaces and from typical school site building heights. Skillfully blend and match colors. Lift heavy objects and perform heavy manual labor. Work effectively in the absence of supervision. Understand and follow oral and written instructions. Communicate effectively, both orally and in writing. Establish and maintain cooperative working relationships with those contacted in the course of work.

LICENSE

Must possess a valid California driver's license and the ability to maintain qualification for district vehicle insurance coverage.

PHYSICAL ABILITY

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to stand; walk; use hands to finger, handle, or feel objects, tools, or controls; talk or hear; and taste or smell. The employee is occasionally required to reach with hands and arms; climb or balance; and stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl.

The employee must regularly lift and/or move up to 25 pounds and occasionally lift and/or move up to 50 pounds. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, color vision, peripheral vision, depth perception, and the ability to adjust focus. The selected candidate must be able to perform the duties of a rigorous work schedule which includes lifting, loading, and unloading, and pass a physical examination and drug screen certifying this ability.
