

PLUMBER

JOB SUMMARY	Under general direction, perform skilled work involving the installation, maintenance and repair of pipes, fittings and fixtures of heating, water, drainage systems and gas lines.
TYPICAL DUTIES	<p>Perform a variety of skilled plumbing tasks. Troubleshoot malfunctions and identify plan of action to resolve problems. Install, maintain and repair air, gas, water, waste, and steam lines. Install, maintain and repair a variety of valves. Maintain and unclog storm drains and sewer lines. Maintain and repair toilets, urinals, sinks, showers and other bathroom fixtures. Maintain and install disposal units, sinks, and other kitchen fixtures. Install and maintain irrigation systems including electronic controls and timers.</p> <p>Maintain and clean drains, gutters and down spouts. Remove and install water heaters and plumbing fixtures. Maintain drinking fountains. Operate a variety of hand and power tools in order to perform assigned tasks. Read plans and specifications. Perform other duties related to this position.</p>
JOB REQUIREMENTS	Any combination of education, training, and/or experience which demonstrate ability to perform the required duties. A typical qualifying background would include graduation from high school or equivalent and journey level experience and training in plumbing installation and repair work.
Knowledge of:	Methods, materials, tools, and equipment used in the plumbing trade. Plumbing codes. Safe work practices. Safe and approved methods in the use of chemicals contacted in the course of duty.
Ability to:	Identify and correct plumbing problems. Install, maintain and repair a variety of fixtures, pipes and lines. Read and work from blueprints and construction drawings. Estimate labor and material costs and ensure appropriate materials and supplies are on hand to complete a job in a timely manner. Work in confined spaces. Lift heavy objects and perform heavy manual labor. Work effectively in the absence of supervision. Understand and follow oral and written instructions. Communicate effectively, both orally and in writing. Establish and maintain cooperative working relationships with those contacted in the course of work.
LICENSE	Must possess a valid California driver's license and the ability to maintain qualification for district vehicle insurance coverage.
PHYSICAL ABILITY	The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to stand; walk; use hands to finger, handle, or feel

objects, tools, or controls; talk or hear; and taste or smell. The employee is occasionally required to reach with hands and arms; climb or balance; and stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl.

The employee must regularly lift and/or move up to 25 pounds and occasionally lift and/or move up to 50 pounds. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, color vision, peripheral vision, depth perception, and the ability to adjust focus. The selected candidate must be able to perform the duties of a rigorous work schedule which includes lifting, loading, and unloading, and pass a physical examination and drug screen certifying this ability.

**WORKING
CONDITIONS**

May be exposed to extreme hot and cold temperatures, either while cooking or storing/retrieving items from the freezer. Lifting, pushing/pulling moderately heavy and/or bulky items. Exposure to loud noises. Extended periods of sitting, walking, and standing.
